This year's Harvest Festival has a number of great events scheduled. Here is a list of all the important dates:

September 20th & 21st - Bauman Family Rewards Weekend - All Family Rewards Members will receive \$5 off admission and new members can sign up at the gate.

September 27th & 28th – Farm Days – This is how farming is done! We will have an collection of farm tractors & farming equipment at the festival, small & large, for you to see and experience up close.

October 4th - Giant Pumpkin Weigh Off & Pumpkin Drop - Giant Pumpkins from across the country will be arriving at the farm by 9:00am to see who has grown the biggest pumpkin and other vegetables. Our coveted Giant Pumpkin Drop will take place at 1:00pm.

October 5th - Spicy Pumpkin Cider release featuring Portland's own Elvira. - To toast this notable milestone in our farm's history, we will be doing a release party for Bauman's Cider new Spicy Pumpkin Cider with no one less than Elvira on Sunday, October 5th!

October 10th - Statewide No School Friday - Since there is no school throughout Oregon, all our activities and food/drink venues are open and operate as if it were a weekend day.

October 25th & 26th - Bauman's Cider Festival - We have invited over 20 cider makers from around the Northwest to bring their top three fall flavors to the farm. Guests will have the opportunity to purchase tickets and taste the ciders to vote for the People's Choice Winner for 2025.

While at Bauman's Harvest Festival, attendees can also enjoy shopping at the farm's country store, bakery and award-winning garden center while enjoying a refreshing cold glass of Bauman's Hard Cider.

Bauman's Harvest Festival starts on Saturday, September 20th and runs for 6 weeks through October 30th.

Hours are: 9 AM to 5 PM, Tuesday through Sunday.

The festival is closed on Mondays.
